SERVE Northern New England is an AmeriCorps Education Only Award Program where students at colleges across the region earn money college while performing community service.

What are the Benefits of Joining SERVE Northern New England?

- ❖ **Make a Difference** on important issues in your community.
- ❖ Receive an **Education Award** for your work.
- ❖ **Network** with student volunteers across Northern New England.
- ❖ Gain valuable **training** and **leadership skills**.
- ❖ Join **AmeriCorps**--be part of a national movement!

What is an Education Award?

After you have finished your service, you will receive an education award to **pay for future college**, or to **pay back your student loans!**

Students may choose to complete one of the following terms of service:

- ◆ 300 hours over one year for \$1,000.
- ◆ 450 hours over one year for \$1,250.
- ◆ 675 hours over one year for \$1,800.
- ◆ 900 hours over one OR two years for \$2,362.

What are the program requirements for AmeriCorps members?

- ◆ Attend an orientation
- ◆ Attend one VCC approved training
- ◆ Complete the required paperwork
- ◆ Serve 300-900 hours and make a difference in your community!

What can I count hours for?

You can count the hours serving your community through:

- Student clubs
- Off campus work study positions that meet community needs
- Service-learning projects
- Internships
- Alternative break trips
- Volunteer Work

Am I Eligible?

If you are:

- A United States Citizen or Lawful Permanent Resident
- Age 17 or older
- Enrolled in a Campus Compact member college or university
- Involved in service to your community
